



# KEY WORD INDEX

This index is designed to find references in the Code easily. Having worked in the electrical field for over 60 years as an apprentice, journeyman, master, electrical inspector, instructor, and author, I realize at times how difficult it is to "find it in the Code."

The Code is laid out in Articles and Chapters starting with Article 90, the introduction. Chapter 1 Article 100 is definitions, Article 110 is requirements for electrical installations. Chapter 2 is wiring and protection with Article 200 use and identification of grounded conductors, Article 210 branch circuits, 215 feeders, 220 calculations and so on. Chapters 2, 3 and 4 are the "meat" of the Code for the electrician in his daily work. Chapters 5, 6, 7 and 8 are for special applications such as hazardous locations, elevators, pools, mobile homes, studios, high-voltage, signs, health care facilities, etc. Chapter 9 is a special chapter with tables and examples.

All the rules are not in the Electrical Code. Example: What is the minimum height of a ceiling paddle fan in a residence? You would find that information in the Mechanical Code.

110.3b in the Code is very important as it states, "all electrical equipment shall be installed as listed." Which means the directions of installation that come with the equipment must be followed.
